

3.17 Travel Subsidy Policy

In order to assist minor Club teams travelling to Provincial Championships or the U12 Year End Event, Ringette BC may provide a subsidy for travel. The subsidy is available once per fiscal year (April 1 to March 31) to qualified and registered teams in good standing.

Eligibility:

- i. Travel must exceed 700 km., one way
- ii. Subsidized transportation may include automobile, bus, boat or air
- iii. Travel by ferry will be calculated as equivalent to 200 km. for purposes of subsidy eligibility
- iv. Applications will only be considered for registered Club and U12 teams
- v. Application must be received by Ringette BC no later than January 31st to be considered
- vi. The team and the LSO must be a registered member in good standing

Subsidy

- a. The total amount available for the travel subsidy will be determined each year by the board of directors and communicated with each LSO no later than December 31st of the current season.
- b. Subsidy rate will be calculated at \$0.46 per km. based on land distance by shortest route between the LSO hometown and the Championship location
- c. Applications will be open between January 1st and January 31st of the current season
- d. All applicants will be notified of the results of their application no later than March 1st of the current season
- e. Subsidy will be paid by cheque or EFT to the LSO of the successful applicants
- f. Subsidy is available only for Ringette BC Provincial Club Championships and/or Ringette BC U12 Year End Event
